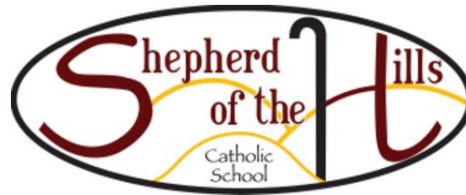




Parent Note
