<u>Activity Highlights:</u>

Faith (We ...)

- attended an All School Mass and participated in Benediction.
- are learning the Act of Contrition during our all school morning Lenten prayer.
- are learning all about the Easter story, this week we gave special attention to Palm Sunday and the Last Super. We made and sent home palm leaves in anticipation of this Palm Sunday weekend.
- are tracking the days of Lent on a Lenten calendar.
- attended the Living Way of the Cross. The children were very attentive and enjoyed the experience.

Language Arts (We...)

- are continuing to make journal entries.
- sent a book home from the School Library.
- finished learning all about the letter Yy.
- continue to talk about Lent and extra acts of kindness that we could do to prepare for Easter.
- are expanding sensitivity of phoneme awareness from beginning word sounds (alliterations) to ending sounds (rhymes).

Math (We...)

- are using shapes.

Social Studies (We...)

- continued playing educational board and card games during learning centers.
