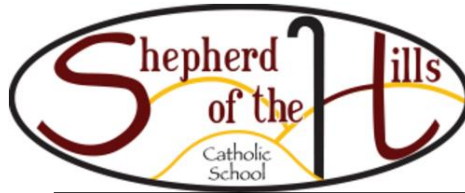


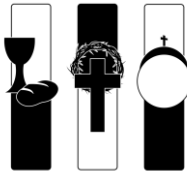

Sneak Peek into next week!

We finished our alphabet recognition and awareness units. At this point students should be familiar with the alphabet and know the sounds that each letter makes. We can begin playing with letter sounds. We have begun learning the proper way to print numbers. We are also adding a few letters to represent the ordinal numbers as we go along.

Activity Highlights:

Faith (We ...)

- **attended an All School Mass and participated in Benediction.**
- are learning the Act of Contrition during our all school morning prayer.
- learned all about the Easter Triduum, by making special picture cards to bring home and unfold over the Triduum celebration.
- finished tracking the 40 days of Lent on a Lenten calendar and began counting our 50 days of Easter on a calendar.
- **prepared for Divine Mercy weekend by focusing on Jesus's great love and mercy.**
- decorated the Crucifix at the school entrance with Divine Mercy pictures and the prayer, 'Jesus I trust in You'.

Language Arts (We...)

- are continuing to make journal entries.
- **sent** a book home from the School Library.
- **finished our alphabet introduction unit Aa-Zz.**
- **are practicing alpha puzzles, putting alphabet together to create words and fine tuning our phoneme awareness for both beginning word sounds (alliterations) and ending sounds (rhymes).**

Math (We...)

- are using shapes and building patterns during calendar time.
- are graphing and comparing weather.
- are working on number comparisons, such as which is the smaller or larger.
- are practicing printing and identifying numeric ordinal names by adding the appropriate letters; st, nd, rd, and th.

Social Studies (We...)

- **played educational board and card games during learning centers.**

Science/Health/Safety (We...)

- had an egg hunt with Dr. Staehling, used eggs in relay races, followed movement directions such as hop to a circle, run to something red...
