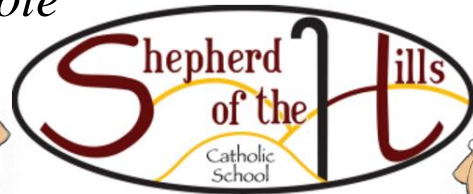


## Parent Note
