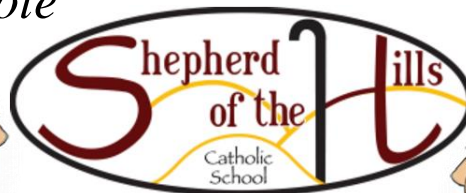


Parent Note
