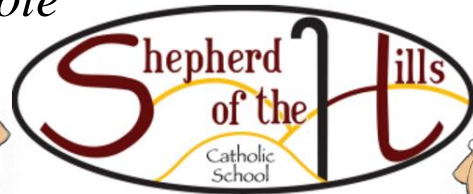


Parent Note
