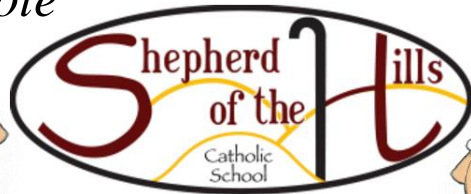


Parent Note

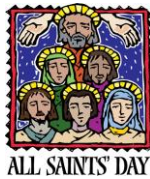
